ROLE OF COACH:

- Every team needs a coach.
- Any parent with a love for sport and teaching young children to improve their skills will thrive as a coach.
- The technical essentials of the game is to hit (from a tee), run to a base, field a ball, catch a ball and throw a ball.
- The coach directs traffic whether in the field or batting, assisting the team with field positioning, where to throw the ball and when batting, where to hit the ball.
- Training should be focused on improving the skills required to play a game. This will include both batting and fielding practice. Manuals are available to assist with fielding drills.
- The main ingredient is that both training and the game is fun with all team members having equal participation and enjoying playing in the team environment.

ROLE OF MANAGER:

- Be the main link of communication between the club and the team
- Advise all parents of:
 - o Training day, time and location.
 - Coach and Manager contact details.
 - Club information and events
- Team Organisation on game day
- Distribute Fixtures and Uniforms
- Parent Roster Coordinate with parents/caregivers regarding involvement in scoring, umpiring, base coaching and canteen volunteers.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT - SCORERS, UMPIRES, BASE COACHES & CANTEEN VOLUNTEERS:

As with any children's sport it is important for parents/caregivers to help to ensure a smooth & fun season. These roles will be allocated by the manager on a rotational basis at the beginning of the season.

If you have experience in any role, please advise your manager. If you are unsure how to complete your role there is training available.

- Plate Umpire:
 - o There will be an Umpire Clinic run at the club room...details to come.
- Base Umpire:
 - o This person positions themselves between 1st and 2nd Base
 - o Their role is to assist the Plate umpire in calling runners safe or out at 1st and 2nd Base.
 - o This person will spend the entire game on the field.
- 1st Base Coach:
 - o Positioned at 1st Base this person assists your team's runners.
 - o This person remains inside the marked lines of the coaches' box during play (when your team is batting).
 - o Assists the runner by guiding them to run through to second base if safe and assisting them when it's safe to run if a fly ball is hit.
- 3rd Base Coach:
 - Positioned at 3rd Base this person assists your team's runners.
 - o This person remains inside the marked lines of the coaches' box during play (when your team is batting).
 - o Assists the runner by guiding them to run through to 3rd base from 2nd base and to home base if safe.
- Scorer:
 - o You will be supplied with the Batting line up and the Score Book, as well as stationary by the manager.
 - o You'll sit behind the Home Plate set back a fair distance to avoid being hit by a stray ball
 - If you have NEVER Scored before and need to learn how to, please make the point of sitting with one of the scorers before your allocated day.
 - A Scorer Cheat Sheet will be supplied by your manager.
- Canteen:
 - o Please arrive at the canteen 10 minutes prior to the start of the game and remain during the game, until 10 minutes after the game.
 - When your team is rostered on you will be playing on Diamond 1 so you can still watch your child.
 - o Please ensure you wear enclosed shoes.
